6 week paid Summer Internship for Grade 11 Students

OBJECTIVE

To provide Grade 11 students with the opportunity to experience working in an Engineering or Science research laboratory on the Ryerson University campus. The participants will learn about Engineering and Science as possible future areas of study and the career paths available in these dynamic fields.

PROGRAM OUTLINE

This program is open primarily to female students in the Greater Toronto Area (GTA) who have just completed their Grade 11 year. Both female and male students are welcome and will be paid to work for a 6 week period as a research assistant on a current Science or Engineering research project.
